#### **11am Livestream Services in March**

"Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful. And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains. Our priority at North River is the spiritual and physical safety of our church family. We want to do all that we can to create an environment where we can stay connected, encouraged, and growing spiritually during this time and still help people get to know the good news of Christ and His kingdom. All of you are in our prayers, and we know that you will let your light shine in your neighborhoods and homes in the days and weeks to come.

Due to COVID-19 concerns, we are suspending all of our physical meetings for the month of March (all church services, gym activities, Women's Month activities, and other large public gatherings) effective immediately. Women's Month events will be rescheduled, likely in the fall. We will communicate changes through our website at <u>www.nrcoc.org</u> and social media.

We will be worshipping together at 11am on Livestream this Sunday and throughout the month of March. <u>THERE WILL BE NO WORSHIP SERVICE AT OUR NORTH RIVER BUILDING</u>. In addition, we will begin doing more things online. We encourage you to worship together and commune with us via the NR Facebook page or on our website. You should prepare to have communion in your homes as well.

#### You can access our virtual service in two ways:

- Go to <u>www.nrcoc.org</u> at 11am beginning this Sunday and click on the tab that says "Watch Live."
- Visit the <u>North River Facebook Page</u> at 11am, and the service will automatically begin at 11am. (If you "like" the NR Facebook page, it will automatically notify you of future livestream events.)

We encourage everyone to join us "live" at 11, but if for some reason you are unable to do this, you can access the recording at any point on our website or on Facebook. There is also a wealth of other sermons, services, and information on the website.

We will be contacting you primarily via email, thus, it is important to update your contact information. If everyone in your small group is not getting this information, please send them this e-mail, and, if needed, help them to <u>enter their information using this link</u>. They can also <u>give contribution here on Tithely</u>. If you have any questions about the form or setting up your online giving, email meganfamodun@nrcoc.com for assistance!

Please use discretion if you are meeting in small groups during the week or on Sunday (many groups will meet virtually). Just remember that children and others can be carriers of a virus, even if not showing symptoms of a virus. We want to take extra precautions to protect our elderly members and any members with an underlying condition, as they are more susceptible.



#### Requesting a Room or Building at North River (All Reservations for Facilities on Hold Through March and April)

As good stewards of all that God gives us, let us keep the following in mind concerning our buildings:

- Members and guests are not permitted to use any rooms without a reservation.
- Bear with each other if you don't get your desired spot or for the time you need it. Flexibility is key!
- Reminder: The FLC and The Lighthouse are NUT-FREE. Please keep this in mind when bringing lunch or potluck meals. Thank you for keeping those with serious food allergies safe.
